


We have been learning about multiples and factors in maths and did small group hands on activities to support our learning. It was fun and interesting and we enjoyed the lesson

EARLY PICK-UP



We'd like to remind all families about the importance of keeping early pick ups to a minimum. Where possible, we encourage families to limit early collection to occasional appointments only, as valuable learning continues right up until our 3:10pm dismissal. Just one 20-minute early pick-up a week amounts to 13 hours of lost learning over the year.

We understand that parking can be challenging during pick up times and appreciate your patience and understanding. To assist, we strongly encourage families to use our Kiss and Drop zone. This area is supervised by staff until 3:30pm each afternoon and generally becomes a low-traffic collection point from about 3:20pm onwards, making for a safe and efficient pick up option.

Please also note that our front office is particularly busy after 2:30pm with disability taxi arrangements and end-of-day management. Minimising early pick ups helps us ensure a smooth and safe finish to the school day for everyone.
