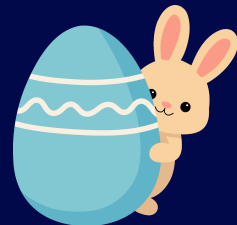

Preschool

Our children's love for the natural environment has blossomed through a recent broad bean planting experience. Using cotton wool, water, cups and broad bean seeds, the children observed their seeds closely, describing them as "smooth," "brown," and "shaped like an ear."

There was much excitement as the children discussed how to help their seeds grow. After planting, we ended the day by singing "A Little Seed" which is a favourite song of the children that explores what a seed needs to thrive: a little earth, a little sun, a little shower, and a little wait.

We placed our seeds on the windowsill, where the children could watch them change and grow. Each day, they eagerly checked for signs of growth, sparking ongoing conversations about caring for plants.

Through this experience, children are learning about how plants grow and are developing a deeper appreciation for gardening and the environment. Here are some of the children's voices:

"We can put it in the ground and let it grow!" (Thalib)

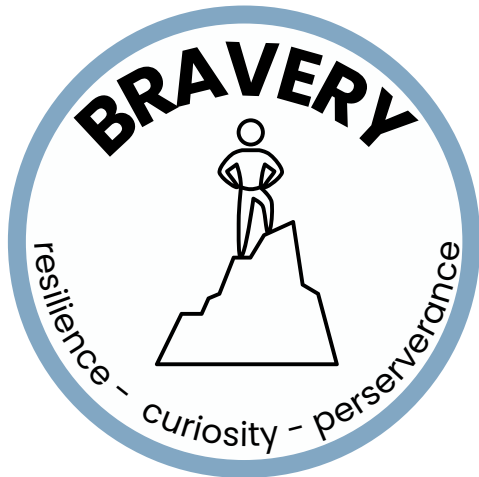
"Beans. I like beans." (Jake)
