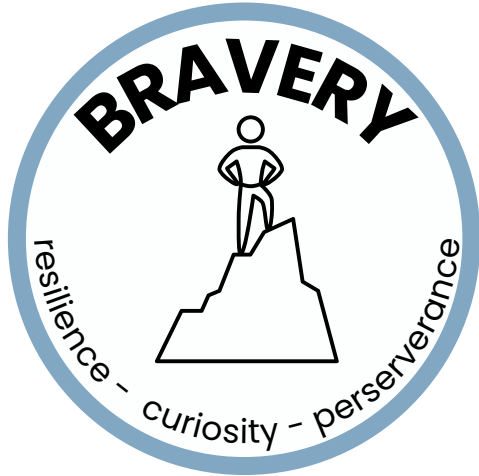
Room 12
