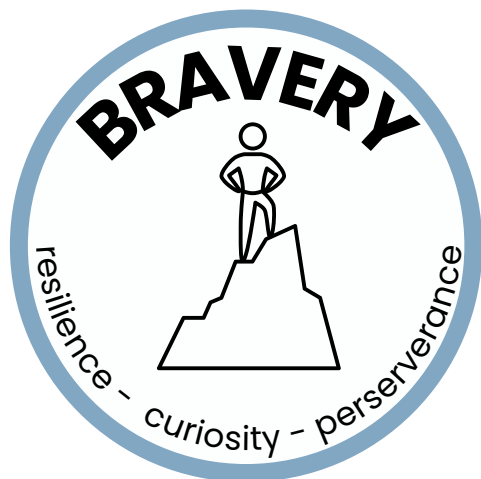

- before 1 May, they're eligible to start preschool in term 1 that year
- between 1 May and 31 October, they're eligible to start preschool in term 3 that year
- after 31 October, they're eligible to start preschool in term 1 the following year
